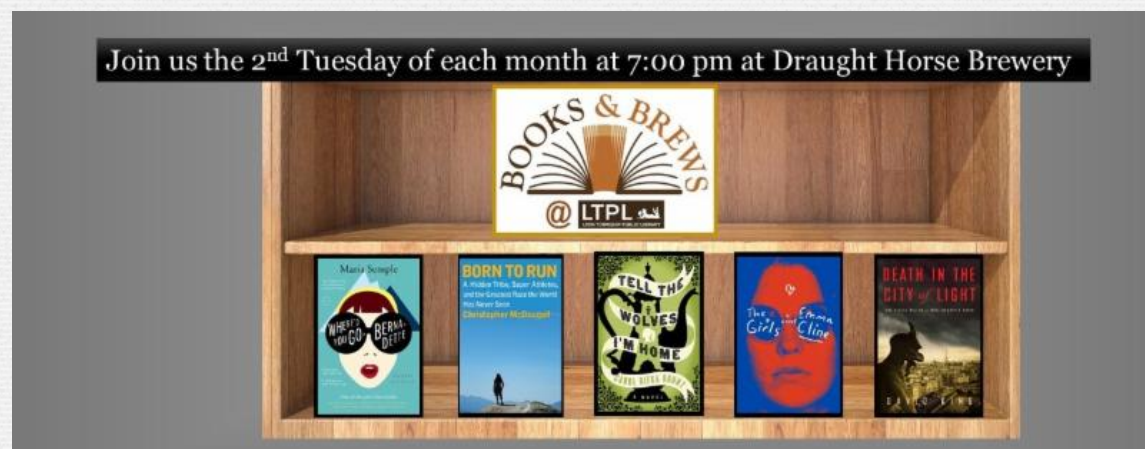
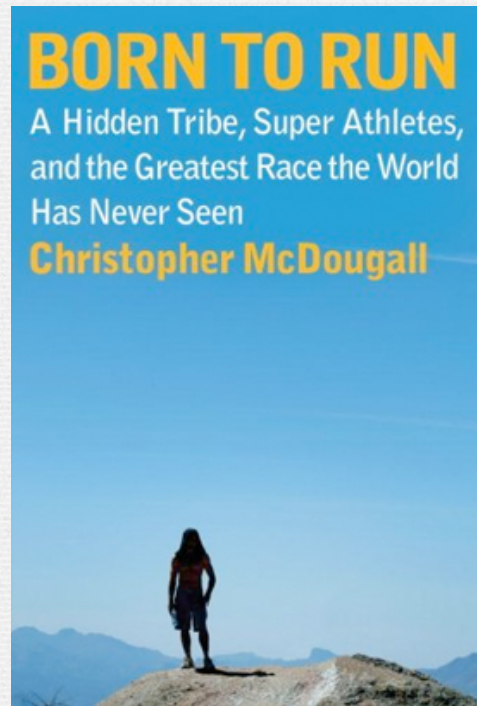
"Born to Run" by Christopher McDougall
