



Lyon Township Public Library to close, effective 5:00 PM Friday, March 13, 2020, through Sunday, April 5, 2020.

On March 10, Governor Gretchen Whitmer, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Oakland County Health Division and Wayne County Health Department announced that two Michigan residents tested presumptive positive for coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

On March 12, Governor Whitmer ordered the closure of all K-12 school buildings, public, private, and boarding, to students starting Monday, March 16 until Sunday, April 5, 2020.

Today, the Lyon Township Library is announcing its closure of the library and the community center at 5 pm, through Sunday, April 5, 2020. All programs, storytimes and classes are cancelled. The Community Center and Library are currently scheduled to reopen on Monday, April 6, 2020.

LTPL will continue to evaluate programs and services on a case-by-case basis and provide updates as they become available.

Please be aware that the library will be closed to the public but will accept returns to the library through the outdoor drop-box.
