Library Services

Guests are asked to visit the library quickly and efficiently (up to 30 minutes) to find and check out materials and ask for assistance:

- The building is open to the public during regular hours of operation, for a limited number of patrons.
- Wearing masks is required (based on current [Executive Order 2020-147](#) and CDC guidelines).
- Masks, gloves, and hand sanitizer are available for use within the library
- Small groups of no more than 1-2 people strongly encouraged.
- Members not of the same household must remain 6 ft. apart.
- Public computers are available for limited use by appointment; ask Staff for a reservation.
- Social distancing and all safety guidelines will be followed (as recommended per State and CDC)
- Furniture and interactive library tech/toys have been removed to ensure guests' safety within the library
- Copy/Faxing services is by request only. Staff will copy or fax for you.
